

Division: Breaking up a number into equal groups

Dividend: The number you are breaking up

Divisor: The amount of groups you are trying to make or the amount of things in each group.

Quotient: Answer to a division problem

Remainder: The amount that is left over, extra

$$116 \div 4 = 29$$

Dividend Divisor Quotient

Dividend → 116 Quotient → 29

Divisor → 4

| - 80 | 20 × 4 = 80 |

| - 36 | 9 × 4 = 36 |

20 + 9 = 29

$$140 \div 4 = 35$$

↑ ↑ · quotient
dividend divisor

$$4 \times \underline{35} = 140$$

Equations:

$$4 \times _ = 140$$

$$4 \times \boxed{20} = 80$$

$$4 \times 10 = 40$$
